The Project is funded by the Government of Georgia (GoG) and the Asian Development Bank (ADB). The Municipal Development Fund of Georgia (MDF) is the project executing agency.

Georgia has received a loan from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) towards the cost of MFF - Sustainable Urban and Transport Investment Program, which is financed through separate tranches. Part of this loan, under Tranche 5, will be used to hire National Waste Management Specialist (the "Consultant"), to provide technical expertise and develop a Waste Management Plan for Tbilisi Transport Company (TTC). The preparation of a Waste Management Plan is a key in achieving sustainable waste management towards improved urban environment in Tbilisi. The primary purpose of the consultant's work is to provide an outline of waste streams and corresponding treatment options in the form of a waste management plan for the operation for all type of public transport under TTC, including Tbilisi Metro, buses and cable cars. The tentative duration of the assignment will be 6 months on the Intermittent Basis.
